Brumbaugh Selected Delegate to National GOP Convention

CLEVELAND - State Representative David Brumbaugh (R) Broken Arrow was selected as a delegate to the 2016 Republican National Convention in Cleveland, Ohio.

Brumbaugh won the designation at the 1st District Convention and was one of 15 district delegates selected statewide.

Broken Arrow Legislator Received Statewide Recognition for Cutting Wasteful Spending

OKLAHOMA CITY - State Representative David Brumbaugh (R) Broken Arrow led the fight in the 2016 legislature to eliminate unnecessary tax credits.

“With our tough financial times in the energy sector and difficulty in having enough revenue to pay for essential services, we need to do away with many of these ‘wasteful’ give-a-ways. We need to make sure that we are giving a ‘hand-up’ not a ‘hand-out’ with the hard earned taxpayers’ money. Corporate welfare is not the job of government”, said Brumbaugh.
