Brumbaugh Bills Gain National Recognition

Several of the Majority Caucus Chairman's bills have gained national attention among property rights and pro-marriage groups throughout the United States.

House Bill 1007

"Protecting Religious Liberty Act"

Protecting licensed or ordained religious officials from solemnizing or recognizing any marriage that violates their conscience or religious beliefs.

House Bill 1008

"Urban Renewal Transparency Act"

Providing longer notice and more public hearings before local governments can take private property using eminent domain.
